Sue - Dino-Sue is located in Dino-Land near the entrance of the ride Dinosaur. She is a reproduction of the T-Rex found in South Dakota.

Forbidden Mountain - The Disco Yeti is found in the Forbidden Mountain on the ride Expedition Everest – Legend of the Forbidden Mountain. The Yeti animatronic moved when the ride was open but stopped working. Imagineers used strobe lights to make it look like the yeti was moving and fans named it Dancing Yeti.

Chester & Hester - The proprietors of Dino-Rama are Chester & Hester. A photography of the couple can be found in Chester & Hester's Dinosaur Treasures.

Russell & Dug Statues - Statues of Russell and Dug are located outside the bird show in Animal Kingdom, Feathered Friends in Flight!

Tree of Life - The Tree of Life is the focal point of Animal Kingdom Over 300 creatures are carved into the trunk. Stroll the trails around the tree to see the craftsmanship that went into building the tree.

Yeti Sign - There are Yeti signs throughout the Asian part of the park near the Everest ride. It's fun to look at the posters and other details in that part of the park.

Dragon Fountain - When you cross the bridge past Nomad Lounge to walk into Pandora, you will see the dragon fountain on the waterway banks. Look off the right side of the bridge to the bank closest to Pandora.

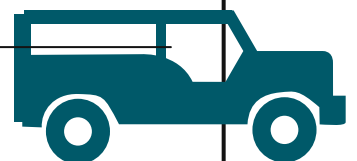
